

Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks Turf Management Internship Opportunity

Positions: The F-M RedHawks have openings for sports-turf interns for the 2007 season. Internships may begin as early as March and extend into Sept. Evening, weekend, and holiday hours are required. People pursuing a degree in turf-management (or related field) are preferred, but it is not a requirement.

Job Description: RedHawks sports-turf interns will have the opportunity to learn the comprehensive aspects of maintaining a professional facility. Hands-on experience will be gained while working in a team environment.

Duties will include

- **Mowing, Edging**
- **Home Plate Maintenance**
- **Laying Sod**
- **Mound and Skin maintenance**
- **Irrigation Maintenance**
- **Equipment Maintenance**
- **Set-up for games and events**
- **Fertilizer and Chemical applications**

Playing Field: The surface is a mix of Kentucky Blue and Perennial Rye growing on a sand based field. The turf and skin are maintained using John Deere equipment. The field is equipped with underground drainage and an irrigation system.

Newman Outdoor Field: The stadium is home to the F-M RedHawks and North Dakota State University. Newman Field host 50 Northern League games along with 12 Division I games a year. Newman Field also hosts a blues fest and a few concerts a year. The RedHawks will be preparing for the 2007 Northern League All-Star Game and American Legion World Series in 2009. Which will be a weeklong tournament played at Newman Field.
